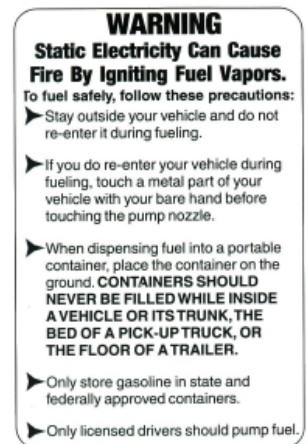

Static Electricity Decals

Static electricity can and does pose danger to customers during refueling, provided customers do not follow proper fueling guidelines. Static electricity safety warning decals for retail motor fuel dispensers are available at PFMA. The decals are 4x6 inches in size, full color and made of high-quality materials, including an ultra-violet protection laminate.



“Drive Off” Decals

House Bill 582 was signed into law as Act 116 of 2002 on October 2, 2002. The bill increases penalties for 'drive offs' and allows for drivers license suspension of repeat offenders.

Under the new law, any person convicted of retail theft of motor fuel may, in addition to any other penalty imposed, be sentenced as follows:

- First offense – A fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$250;
- Second offense – A fine of not less than \$250 nor more than \$500; and
- Third or more offense – A fine of not less than \$500, or the court may order the operating privilege of the person suspended for 30 days.

Drive off decals for your motor fuel dispensers and store front doors are available. The decals are 4x6 inches in size, full color and made of high-quality materials, including an ultra-violet protection laminate.

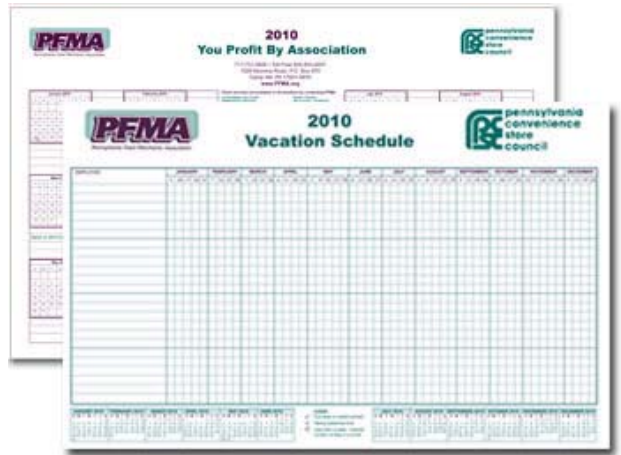


Employee Health & Personal Hygiene Handbook
